CRATING, PARKING AND OTHER INFORMATION

Thank you to those competitors who volunteered to help at our trial. Please check in with the ring manager before the class to avoid excess announcements.

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded.

There will be a food vendor onsite and portable bathrooms.

Dr Susan Elkins, VMD will be available onsite throughout the weekend.

All tenting, kenneling and parking will be restricted to designated areas. As with all spectator venues, you are encouraged to present yourself and your dog in the best manner possible, including attire and sportsmanship. Help us to preserve such venues by following all show ground rules. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

The traffic is one-way all weekend, with the entrance on Route 82 and the exit on Route 926. Since the car parking is as close to tenting area as the road is, **THERE WILL BE NO DROP-OFF OF EQUIPMENT/CRATES** on the driveway. **ALL** exhibitors will be expected to drive to the car parking area directly, **PARK IN ORDER OF ARRIVAL**, and carry all belongings to the tenting area. The RV parking area is to the right, and the car parking will be to the left of the gravel road. There are private residences on the grounds, and a private barn area. Please do not enter these areas, and drive under 15 miles per hour at all times.

THE SPEED LIMIT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AND YOU WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE TRIAL FOR VIOLATING THE SPEED LIMIT.

RV RESERVATIONS

Onsite RV parking/car & tent camping, with NO Hookups, will be available on a reservation only basis, first come, first served and restricted to designated parking areas only. There are approximately 40 spots.

There will be NO day of event spot acquisition. *No* RV Arrivals after 10pm.

If you signed up for an RV reservation someone will bring you into the RV lot and direct you to your designated spot.

CHECK-IN & MEASURING

No competitors may enter premises prior to 6am. Competitors may setup on Thursday after 2pm. If you want to reserve a good crating spot, competitors may come as early as 10:30am to help set up. Tents may not be setup until the rings are done, however you may put down your tarps to reserve a spot upon arrival.

Check-in shall be from 7:00 am to 8:00 am on Friday. From 7:00AM to 7:30AM on Saturday and Sunday. All times are tentative and subject to change. Please stay tuned to announcements throughout the weekend for schedule changes.

There will be two types of check-in, Full Service and Express. Each dog is a unique entry; just because one dog may not need to check-in/measure-in does not mean that all of your dogs entered are able to do so as well.

Full service check-in is required if you did not provide a photocopy of a yellow height card for each dog. Those who cannot present their permanent or completed temporary USDAA cards, or USDAA issued check-in letter, or whose dogs are NOT jumping the maximum height, will be required to "measure-in". Any who have not been measured or checked-in prior to running may forfeit their runs.

NEW FOR REGIONAL EVENTS

Dogs that are entered in tournament events and do not have a permanent yellow height card **MUST** be measured even if their blue temporary card has 3 measurements and the owner is awaiting a CMJ. This policy does not apply to dogs entered in test classes only.

Also, if you are due a refund, or still owe us money, please use full service check-in. If you do owe us money, this must be paid at time of check-in or you will not be permitted to run.

Express check-in is required and available for those who provided photocopies of yellow height cards. You must check yourself in and verify your Registration number; if you missed verifying it in your confirmation, this will be your final chance to do so.

If you are unsure of the check-in/measuring-in procedure, odds are you need to have your dog measured. Bring your dogs that need measuring AND their temporary height cards (the blue ones) to the measuring line BEFORE getting in the check-in line.

Check-in and measuring rules will be enforced at this trial. If you are not present for check-in and/or measuring you will not be permitted to run. If you do run without checking-in and/or measuring, your scores will be pulled and forfeited.

SCHEDULE

Due to the fact that this is a Regional competition, we have large entry numbers. There is a strong possibility that we will run late on all 3 days, including Sunday. Please make your travel plans accordingly. We have 488 dogs entered with approximately 3,500 runs for the weekend.

WE CANNOT MAKE ACCOMMODATIONS TO RUN COMPETITORS OUT OF ORDER BASED ON TRAVEL PLANS, FLIGHTS, ETC.

FAULT LIMITS MAY BE APPLIED in all classes for which faults are assessed. Limits, if any, shall be announced during the judges' briefings. In the event that entries exceed levels that are deemed manageable for this event, one class each day may be rescheduled for another day or cancelled. If a class should be cancelled, a full refund for the class may be made. USDAA and/or Keystone Agility Club assumes no additional liability related to reschedule or cancellation of classes for any reason.

Tournament classes and most Masters/P3 titling classes will be split into groups in order to minimize conflicts. You will be assigned to the same group for the entire weekend. All members of a Team will also be assigned to the same group.

DIRECTIONS

Willowdale Steeplechase
101 West Street Road
Kennett Square, PA 19348

From West Chester: Take Route 202 South, after merges with 322 East, go right onto Route 926 West about 8 miles to Route 82. Go right onto 82 and entrance is on your right.

From the North: Take I95 South (or I295 to Commodore Barry to I95) to Route 322 West to Route 1 South (about 9 miles) to Route 82 North toward Willowdale. Follow 82 North about 1 mile. Just past 926, entrance on right.

Or from the North: Take PA turnpike to King of Prussia exit, to Route 202 South and follow West Chester directions.

Or from the North and East: Take PA turnpike to Rte 476 South. Exit at Route 1 South toward Lima about 19 miles to Route 82 North toward Willowdale. Follow 82 North about 1 mile, just past 926, entrance on right.

From the South: I95 North to Exit 100 (Northeast/Rising Sun) to Route 272 North to Route 1 North to Route 82 North toward Willowdale/Kennett Square. Just past 926, entrance on right.
