All entries must be received no later than Monday, March 1, 6:00 pm. There will be a secondary closing date for this trial for advancement in level which must be received no later than Monday, March 8, 6pm via eMail or telephone to the trial secretary **only**. The contact information is listed above.

There may be **no** hand delivery of entries. All entries must be mailed to the address listed on the Official Entry Form. **Express entries MUST have signature waived.**

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (for minors, signed by parent or legal guardian), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees.

You must file a separate entry form if you enter more than one dog (i.e. only one dog per form) or if you enter the same dog in more than one jump height in the same program.

All dogs must be registered with USDAA (registration has a "U" prefix for Championship & Performance classes and "J" prefix for JHP classes). To obtain a registration number immediately and a height card prior to the show, register your dog online at <http://www.usdaa.com>, General Information, Dog Registration OR complete the registration form included in this test schedule and submit with your entry.

Dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. A registration card and number with a "U" prefix will be issued to facilitate entry at USDAA events and tracking of show results in the regular classes.

Junior handlers (those 18 years of age and younger) and their dogs must be separately registered for participation in the USDAA's Junior Handler Program (UJHP). A registration number with a "J" prefix will be assigned for use in entering UJHP events. A dog competing in both programs (regular classes and UJHP) must be registered separately for each program, for which the total fee is \$37.00.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, which are hereby incorporated by reference, including, but not limited to, the following rules and conditions for submission and acceptance of entry: USDAA's official rules & regulation as amended July 1, 2009 are hereby incorporated by reference.

This test is open to all dogs at least eighteen months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's ability to perform safely, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.

All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. Registration may be made online at a reduced rate with the USDAA or registration may be made concurrently with entry to this show, a form for which is included in this Agility Test Schedule.

No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided in USDAA rules and regulations.

Safety shall always be of foremost consideration at all times. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves, their guests and the actions of their dogs.

Electronic Timing will be used at this event.

Agility obstacles shall meet the requirements of USDAA Rules and Regulations.

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee view that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

No entries shall be accepted, changed, altered or withdrawn for any reason after the closing date.

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded.

Fault limits may be applied in all classes for which faults are assessed. Limits, if any, shall be announced during the judges' briefings.

In the event that entries exceed levels that are deemed manageable for this event, one class may be cancelled. If a class should be cancelled, a full refund for the class may be made. USDAA and/or Lehigh Valley Dream Weavers Agility Club and/or Keystone Agility Club assumes no additional liability related to reschedule or cancellation of classes for any reason.

REFUNDS: There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. Partial refunds for bitches in season and injured dogs will be made, provided you produce a signed letter from a licensed 3rd party veterinarian within 24 hours of the end of show; this does not include dogs that are injured during or after the trial. No entry fee will be refunded if the Test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY: In the event of unpaid entry fees due to an NSF check, Lehigh Valley Dream Weavers Agility Club or Keystone Agility Club may collect from the competitor within thirty (30) days of notice of NSF. If such fees are not collected within thirty (30) days of notice, the club will notify the USDAA of delinquency for cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number to the delinquent entry. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution for replacement and distribution of awards. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler. All NSF Checks carry a \$25 penalty.

DOGS MUST REMAIN ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES, except when competing in the ring or in the warm-up jump area.

No dogs may be left unattended except when properly kenneled in designated kennel areas. Day kenneling only is permitted, unless otherwise posted at the show. USDAA, Lehigh Valley Dream Weavers Agility Club and Keystone Agility Club can and do not assume any liability for loss of any items left unattended. Dogs must be exercised only in designated area. Please pick up after your dog.

CHECKING IN AND MEASURING IN:

Check-in shall be from 7:15am to 7:45am on Saturday and Sunday. There will be a second check-in prior to the start of Steeplechase/PSJ Saturday, actual time to be determined after closing date. All times are tentative and subject to change. Consult your final confirmation for schedule changes.

Check-in: All competitors must check-in at the check in table during the morning check-in time. Competitors that included a copy of their yellow (NOT BLUE!) permanent height card with their entry form may use Express check-in and you are then exempt from measuring in. At Express check in you must check yourself in and verify your Registration number. If you missed verifying it in your confirmation, this will be your final chance to do so.

Measuring-in: All dogs must be measured-in during the morning check in time UNLESS the dogs jumps 26" (22" Performance), the handler sent a copy of the permanent card with entry or presents the permanent card, temporary card with three signatures awaiting a CMJ, or check-in letter from USDAA/print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicating dog is permanently carded. A dog that measures up will run first in the higher height for all classes. If the dog is unprepared for the higher height, it may be run For Exhibition Only, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned and no change in program is permitted at check-in.

TEST SITE:

No competitors may enter premises prior to 7 am on Saturday and Sunday. There will be **absolutely no** competitor setup on Friday.

There will be a food vendor on site for on Saturday & Sunday only but no running water. Port-A-Potties will be available on site.

This trial is being held in fabric building with artificial turf in the agility ring. The building has propane heaters located on the ceiling. Even with the heat running, it can be chilly so please be prepared for cold weather with plenty of towels for people and doggie feet, and blankets for doggie warmth. If crating in the car, please check dog's comfort often. Crating space is limited and cramped, please do not bring un-entered dogs. Crating inside is first come, first serve. Stacking/Stackable crates are strongly encouraged. If you are planning on using x-pens, please get in touch with one of our chair-persons **before** the trial. Depending on the weather, condensation can drip in the winter, so please bring cover for your dog crates.

All tenting, kenneling and parking will be restricted to designated areas. As with all spectator venues, you are encouraged to present yourself and your dog in the best manner possible, including attire and sportsmanship. Help us to preserve such venues by following all show ground rules. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. This also applies to all hotel/motels. Your cooperation in cleaning up after all dogs, using sheets on the beds and towels for doggie feet in case of inclement weather is required.

Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance Program classes for which they are eligible; however, under NO circumstance may a dog be entered in more than one level or program for any given class (i.e. Masters Gamblers may not enter any other level/program of gamblers).

TOURNAMENT CLASSES

Dog Agility Steeplechase® and Performance Speed JumpingSM

These two-rounded tournaments are open to all competitors regardless of titles earned or skill level. A qualifying score is earned in round 1. **Steeplechase**: One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in a Regional Championships, and two are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships. **Speed Jumping**: Two qualifying scores as described in the complete rules are required for entry in the semifinals at the World Championships.

Awards: (Steeplechase)

Local Qualifiers; Prize money shall be computed based upon 20% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class. *Allocable amounts to finalist positions that are not filled for any reason or allocable prize amounts less than \$3.00 shall not be paid.

Awards: (Performance Speed Jumping)

Local Qualifiers; Prize money shall be computed based upon 20% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class. *Allocable amounts to finalist positions that are not filled for any reason or allocable prize amounts less than \$3.00 shall not be paid.

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® and Performance Grand PrixSM

A qualifying score is zero faults. One Q is required for entry in a Regional Championships, where a bye into the semifinals or finals may be earned. Two qualifying scores are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships.

Awards (Grand Prix)

First place qualifying winner in each height class shall be awarded a "bye voucher", permitting them to advance to the final round of a regional championship. A double overlay maroon and white ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers. 1st – 6th place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height.

Awards (Performance Grand Prix)

First place qualifying winner in each height class shall be awarded a "bye voucher", permitting them to advance to the final round of a regional championship. A double overlay maroon and pink ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers. 1st-3rd place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded.
